BUILDING DEPARTMENT REPORT: There were 46 permits issued for the month of July there were 18 building permits, (1 new house) 7 electrical, 13 mechanical and 8 plumbing, 2 reinspection fees for a total fee of \$7,714.00

NEW BUSINESS:

BLIGHT: The Township Attorney has met with and discussed open Blight cases with the Blight officer. Trustee Woelmer has been working on resolving mowing issues at the DGMarket.

Clerk Fetterly and Al Bruck gave a report on the fire hydrant maintenance on the south side of the river. Report on file in the Clerk's Office

MOTION BY: Trustee Jaworski, **SUPPORTED BY:** Treasure Beaudrie to approve changes to the permit applications excluding Building applications. The township will keep 100% of the application fee, and add a final inspection to every application. The Board needs to discuss this with the Building Dept before it takes effect. **MOTION CARRIED**

Clerk Fetterly gave an update to the repairs to the headstones at Doty Cemetery, the Eagle Scouts with the Help of Al Bruck is doing a great job, it is greatly appreciated. They discovered a lot of old pieces of stone, after some research discovered they were plot corner markers, none of them had any information carved on them except for once in a while initials, which was determined matched the headstone in the area. The Township did not want to just stack them in the corner, or remove them from the cemetery, so it was decided to bury them in the cemetery by the flag pole.

Clerk Fetterly gave an update on the 8/3/2026 election 31% turnout.
